Hard to Find Lladro

There is Lladro and there is Lladro. There are collectors and there are Collectors. We like to think of ourselves as servicing and specializing in those hard to find, often rare and valuable pieces most sought after by the truest and more discriminating Lladro Collectors. This year Lladro is celebrating the 15th Anniversary of [#S-7600G Little Pals](#). Looking back to 1985, there were several retired favorites.

[#LL-1317G Ducks at the Pond](#) has only been located twice since we began servicing the secondary market. This Limited Edition of 1,200 is considered very rare and is pictured on our Back cover. One of the more popular figurines from 1985 is [#L-5145G Schoolgirl "A"](#), one of five (5) vowels (all are available upon request). My own favorite, [#L-5176G Lady Lying on Divan a/k/a Rhapsody in Blue](#), is a bargain at only \$1,500. This piece sold at auction in 1990 for \$1,150. Along with Little Pals, other clowns that retired in 1985, included [#L-4605G Magic](#), [#L-5052G At The Circus](#) and [#L-5056G Clown with Alarm Clock](#) (one in a set of five, complete set available upon request). [#L-1033G Old Folks](#) is a frequent request from collectors of all ages. [#L-2130M Egyptian Cat](#) is black as night, a stunning Gres piece. Along with Little Pals, you'd have to say that 1985 was a good year for buying appreciable Lladro!

It's always tricky to find that next Little Pals; originally issued for \$95 and now available at \$2,400.00 + shipping! Our pick for year 2000 is [#LL-7678M Scheherazade](#). The book says that 1,000 pieces were made of which only 200 were distributed in the United States. The original issue price was \$975.00 and we are offering ours at \$2,500. AND, what will it be worth in 2015 ?

Along with Scheherazade, we have two of the earliest Limited Editions Lladro ever made. [#LL-1145G Othello and Desdemona](#) (750 pieces) and [#LL-1243G The Forest](#) (500 pieces). These two figurines date way back to 1971 and 1973, respectively (all pictured here).

Two interesting Limited Editions in the Goyescas collection from 1991 are [#LL-1745M Dawn](#) (200 pieces) and [#LL-1749M Baggy Pants](#) (300 pieces). There are 53-pieces in the Goyescas collection, inspired by the works of legendary 18th century painter, Francisco Goya. Master Sculptor, E. Sanidro, created all with intricate detail in deeply etched surfaces of vivid color.

Last, but not least, we have three very unusual and **HARD TO FIND LLADRO** "decorative functional pieces" (as described by Lladro) otherwise known, more simply, to us ordinary folk as "vases." [#L-4693G Decorative Pheasant](#) and [#L-4770G/M Don Quixote Vase](#), both from the early 1970's. If you remember [#L-7500M Thimble](#), issued in 1983, we have a matching [#L-7502M Miniature Vase](#), issued in 1988; both sold exclusively by The Franklin Mint. Well, we have both vase and thimble.
